WECOME TO OUR FARMSTEAD! Adjacent to and behind the farmhouse are twelve or thirteen beds laid out like the markings on a cow with grassy walkways around each bed. However, you may not notice the layout, as you will be looking up at the approximate 300 lilies, some reaching up to 5 or 7 feet or more! Be sure to have your camera ready for great shots of towering lilies from nearly all the lily divisions. Our collection includes around 50 lily species and varieties of species, some or most you've probably never seen before.

Across the driveway is our large vegetable garden which no longer grows vegetables! It is now growing our baby lilies from tiny seedlings to towering, six foot, mature hybrids of our own breeding and from seeds from the North American Lily Society seed exchange.
